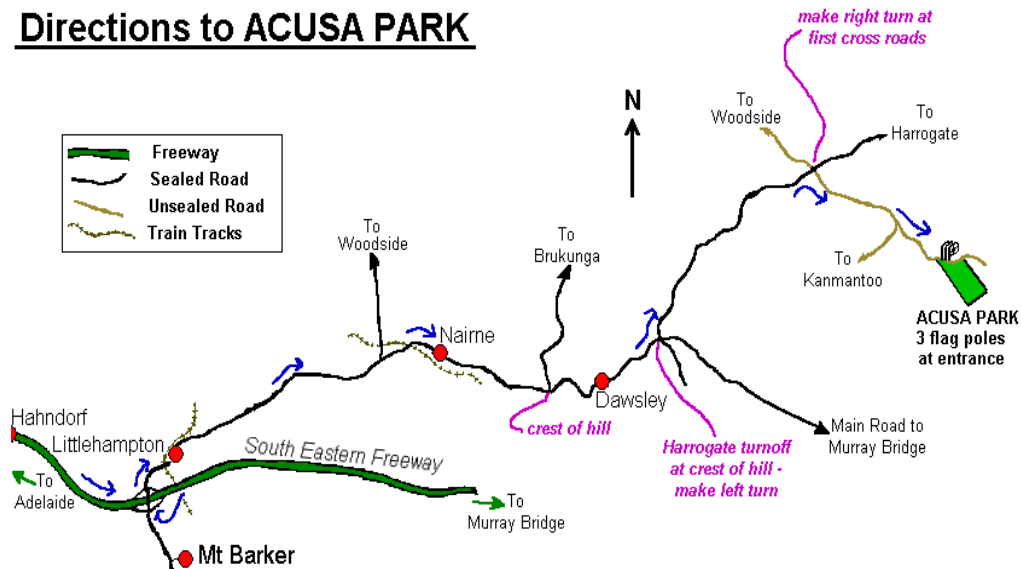
Yet another month has passed and with the biggest ever field of riders turning up on Easter Monday, it was a credit to the organizers and track preparation with the way the event ran without a problem.

This year, the property has been booked out for Morgan MCC members only, **SO YOU WILL NEED TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARDS WITH YOU**. The format of the day is very casual, but gives you access to the two motocross tracks, the short circuit track (which all the juniors get addicted to) and the Enduro Loop.
